

Where does your pledge money goes?

The majority of All Faiths' budget is for staff salaries, benefits, workers compensation, and payroll fees (\$163,701). Other major expense categories are building expenses, insurance, lawn, repairs, janitorial & utilities, and the capital reserve fund. The capital reserve fund finances our anticipated future capital expenditures. Besides these essential items, your generosity supports the day-to-day operations and social outreach of the Congregation.
