Stewardship/Legacy - *Without stewardship and our pledge campaign, All Faiths couldn't exist. We need three or four people to solidify a strong committee. You won't be reinventing the wheel, just steering it! Pledge campaign work begins in December and ends in February on Founders' Day. Stewardship and legacy giving go hand in hand. Program/Event Support - *This is a much needed and important role. Everyone likes an occasional Sunday BBQ, or an evening event. We need people who are willing to rearrange/setup the community room, pick up food and beverages when necessary, put out food and clean up afterwards. Memorial Garden and Grounds - *our garden and grounds take a lot of tending too. Trimming, weeding, watering. You don't have to go it alone.
